

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE KNOLLYS ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable works involving a crane operation to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Knollys Road which lies between the common boundary of Nos. 86 and 88 Knollys Road and the common boundary of Nos. 100 and 102 Knollys Road.
2. Alternative routes would be available for affected vehicles via (i) Leigham Vale, Norwood Road and York Hill and vice versa; and (ii) York Hill, Royal Circus, Glennie Road and Leigham Court Road and vice versa.
3. The ban would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
4. The order would come into force on 8th December 2018 and would continue for a maximum duration of 2 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.
