## **Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

### **The Lewisham (Dunoon Road, SE23)**

#### **(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1.** (a) Road closure and no parking/waiting in Dunoon road, SE23 between Devonshire road and Fairlee Gardens. (b) The alternative routes for traffic affected are via Devonshire Road, Boveney Road, Hengrave Road, Honor Oak Park and Honor Oak Road or Devonshire Road, Tyson Road and Honor Oak Road, and vice versa.
- 2.** Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3.** The order comes into force on the 1st February 2019 to remain in force for up to 12 months. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.

(Note: Access will be maintained for residents where ever practicable)
