## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Goodwood Road and Batavia Road, SE14) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below.

- 1. (a) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Goodwood Road, SE14 between Batavia Mews and Auburn Close, and (ii) Batavia Road, SE14 between Goodwood Road and Batavia Mews. (b) The alternative routes for traffic affected by the closure in article 1.(a)(i) are via either Goodwood Road, New Cross Road and Clifton Rise or Achilles Street, Pagnell Street, New Cross Gyratory system, New Cross Road, Sainsbury's access road and Goodwood Road. There are no alternative routes for the closure of Goodwood Road between Batavia Road and Auburn Close
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- The order comes into force on the 2nd January 2019 to remain in force for up to 6 months. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.

(Note; Works will be done in phases to minimise disruption)
