

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – ALBERT SQUARE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable water main repair works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of Albert Square which lies between Clapham Road and a point 20 metres north-west of Clapham Road.
2. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes will be available for all vehicles affected by the closure via (a) Clapham Road, Stockwell Terrace, South Lambeth Road and Aldebert Terrace and vice versa; and (b) Clapham Road, Dorset Road, Bolney Street and Wilkinson Street and vice versa.
4. The order will come into force on 11th March 2019 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order will have effect from 11th March 2019 for approximately 10 days but if the works cannot be completed or carried out during that time the order will also have effect on subsequent dates within the maximum period of 1 month.
