

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
PROPOSED REDUCTION OF A PARKING SPACE IN
BLAIRDERRY ROAD TO ENABLE SAFE ACCESS TO A
BIN CHAMBER

(NOTE: This Notice is about proposals to remove a length of parking space and replace it with at any time waiting restrictions (indicated by double yellow lines) so as to allow safe access to and from a bin chamber. Objections may be made – see paragraph 6.)

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth propose to make the Lambeth (Streatham Hill West “G”) (Parking Places) (No. **) Order 201* and the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) (Amendment No. ***) Order 201* under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The general effect of the Orders would be to reduce a length of a shared use residents’/business/pay and display parking in Blairderry Road which lies on the south-east side, by 3.9 metres and install double yellow lines in that length of road instead.

3. The proposed Orders are required to prevent parking where it would be an obstruction particularly to refuse collection vehicles requiring access to and from the bin chamber at this site.
