

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS
FOR CARRIAGEWAY RESURFACING AND PLANNED
MAINTENANCE WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable carriageway resurfacing and planned maintenance works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth, with the agreement of Transport for London and Croydon Council, have made an order the effect of which will be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering or waiting (including waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading a vehicle) in the streets and parts of streets specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (b) ban vehicles proceeding in Streatham High Road from turning right into Green Lane (alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (i) Streatham High Road, Streatham Common North, Crown Lane, Beulah Hill, Norbury Hill and Green Lane; and (ii) Streatham High Road, Gleneagle Road, Ambleside Avenue, Tooting Bec Gardens and Streatham High Road).

2. Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by the bans described in paragraph 1(a) above, via adjacent roads as indicated by traffic signs.

3. The bans and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing and covering of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The order will come into force on 17th February 2019 and will continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

SCHEDULE

(i) Baylis Road, between Waterloo Road and a point 13 metres south of Lower Marsh; **(ii)** Blairderry Road; **(iii)** Ernest Avenue; **(iv)** Green Lane, between the common boundary of Nos. 330 and 332 Green Lane and Granville Gardens; **(v)** Leigham Court Road, between a point 5 metres north-west of Valley Road and Streatham Common North; **(vi)** Park Hall Road, between Chancellor Grove and South Croxted Road.
