

## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM PUBLIC NOTICE

## **Town & Country Planning Act 1990**

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM hereby gives NOTICE that it proposes to make an order under section 247 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of:-

Part of the existing forecourt on the northern section of Morley Road to allow the building to extend up to the back of the public footpath (illustrated on the proposed Stopping Up plan).

**THE PROPOSED ORDER** is to enable the proposed building line to extend up to the back of the public footpath in accordance with:-

the planning application applied for the London Borough of Lewisham under registration no DC/18/109604 for the construction of a part 4/part 6 building to provide 388 sqm of flexible commercial (A1/A2/A3/B1 use classes) floorspace at ground floor, and 127 hotel rooms on the upper floors with ancillary dining facilities, and refuse and recycling storage and cycle storage at 223-229 Lewisham High Street, SE13, the drawings submitted as part of the application for the above application.
