

LICENSING ACT 2003

Notice of Application for Variation of Premises Licence

NOTICE IS GIVEN THAT an application has been made to Lewisham Council (the Licensing Authority) for a variation to the Premises Licence by On Blackheath Limited in respect of On Blackheath Festival, Blackheath Common, London, SE3.

The details of the application are as follows:

To vary the existing licence with regard to dates. The proposed change is to amend the licence to 'Any consecutive two day period between 1st July and 31st September in any calendar year, with the dates for each year to be agreed at least 6 months in advance of the date of the event with the licensing authority, the Council's ESAG (Events Safety Advisory Group) and the appropriate executive director (agreement to be issued in writing by Licensing Authority)'.

AND the addition of a new site plan.

Details of the application may be inspected by appointment only at Crime, Enforcement & Regulation Service, Licensing Authority, Holbeach Office, 9 Holbeach Road, SE6 4TW.

Any interested party or responsible authority may make representations in respect of the application, which must be submitted, in writing, to the above address within 28 days of the date below.

This notice remains in force from and including the day after the giving of this notice to the licensing authority, namely 12th February 2019 for 28 consecutive days.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application. The maximum fine on summary conviction is £5,000.
