ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) (NO. 2) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable railway bridge works to take place on Bermondsey Street.

3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering.

- exiting or proceeding on Bermondsey Street between its junction with St Thomas Street and Magdalen Street.

 The Order will be effective at certain times from 10:00 PM on the 26th
 - February 2019 to 6:00 AM on the 27th February 2019 or when the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Snowfields, Weston Street, Long Lane, Bermondsey Street, Tower Bridge Road, Roper Lane, Druid Street, Tooley Street and return to normal route of travel.
