ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (CRUCIFIX LANE, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2019

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable bridge inspection works to take place on the A200 Crucifix Lane.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding on Crucifix Lane, between its junctions with Druid Street and Barnham Street.
- 4. The Order will be effective at each night from 10:00 PM on 1st May 2019 until 6:00 AM on 2nd May 2019 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 5. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the traffic prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via A I 00 Tower Bridge Road, Tanner Street and Bermondsey Street on to normal route of travel.
