THE A205 GLA ROAD AND GLA SIDE ROAD (NORWOOD ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2019

TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 201

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lambeth hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow water main replacement works to take place on Norwood Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right from Station Rise into Norwood Road northbound; (2) turning right from Parade Mews into Norwood Road southbound;
 - (3) stopping in the Parking bay outside Nos. 180 to 190 Norwood Road;
 - (4) stopping in the Loading bay outside Nos. 371 to 375 Norwood Road;
 - (5) entering or proceeding in the northbound contraflow bus lane on Norwood Road between its junctions with Christchurch Road and
 - (6) entering, proceeding or stopping on Perran Road between its junction with Norwood Road and the extended common boundary of Nos. 11 to 13 Perran Road:
 - (7) entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Leigham Vale between its junction with Norwood Road and the extended eastern building line of No. 151 Palace Road.

The Order will be effective from 6:00 AM on the 6th April 2019 to 6:00 PM on the 19th March 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs. For Perran Road via Norwood Road and Christchurch Road to normal route of travel.
