- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to:
 - ban all vehicles, except pedal cycles from entering Mina Road at its junction with Ivy Church Lane;
 - convert the existing 24 metre Parking bay outside Nos. 7 to 33
 West Lane and the 11 metre Loading bay opposite Nos. 7 to 33
 West Lane to borough controlled areas;
 - 3) formalise the removal of the 11 metre Loading bay opposite No.166 Tower Bridge Road and the extension of the existing 12 metre Loading bay opposite No. 160 to 164 Tower Bridge Road to 24 metres:
- The roads which would be affected by the Order are the A2 GLA Side Road – Mina Road, A200 GLA Side Road – West Lane and A100 GLA Road – Tower Bridge Road in the London Borough of Southwark.
