- (i) Avonley Road on the west side, outside Filton Court, and on the east side between the boundary of nos. 56 and 58 Avonley Road and the northern flank wall of no. 58 Edric Road (ii) Batavia Road on both sides at its junction with Goodwood Road, and on the south side from its junction with Goodwood Road to its junction with Batavia Mews (iii) Blackhorse Road extending existing 'no waiting at any time' restrictions on the north and south sides at the entrances/egresses to Deptford Trading Estate (iv) Goodwood Road on the east side from its junction with Auburn Close
- (b) **Boone Street** east side, replace existing 'no waiting at any time' restrictions with a new unrestricted parking bay opposite nos. 102 to 116 Boone Street.

to its junction with Batavia Road excluding inset unrestricted parking areas, and on the west side with its junction with Batavia Road.

- Boone Street north side, replace existing 'no waiting and loading at any time' restrictions with a new unrestricted parking bay opposite nos. 13 to 35 Boone Street.
