ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A5205 GLA ROAD (ST. JOHN'S WOOD ROAD, CITY OF WESTMINSTER) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ORDER 2019

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is facilitate the control and safety of traffic attending the ICC Cricket World Cup event at the Lord's Cricket Ground on A5205 St John's Wood Road.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except those
 - vehicles used in connection with the ICC Cricket World Cup event from stopping in the:
 - Bus stand sited opposite Dora House, No.60 St Johns Wood Road;
 - (2) Loading and Unloading Bay opposite The Liberal Jewish Synagogue, No.28 St Johns Wood Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 5:00 AM and 8:00 PM on 23rd June 2019, 25th June 2019 and 5th July 2019, and also between 5:00 AM and 11:00 PM on 14th July 2019 and 15th July 2019 and finally between 5:00 AM on 29th June 2019 and 00:01 AM on 30th June 2019 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
