- The general effect of the Orders would be: (1) to introduce parking places for the charging of electric vehicles ("electric vehicle charging places") at the locations specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice (these parking places, the length of which is specified in brackets next to the locations, would operate at any time and during these hours only electric vehicles may park in them for a maximum period of 1 hour while charging, no return within 2 hours;

- Nos. 224 and 226 (length 3.5 metres); (d) Wandsworth Road outside No. 475 (length 2 metres); (e) Weir Road outside No. 5 (length 10.7 metres) and (f) Windmill Drive opposite The Windmill public house (length 7 metres); where there is existing parking space in the locations specified in the Schedule to this Notice or in paragraph 2(2) above, to remove or reduce in length that parking space to
- accommodate the electric vehicle charging places and the electric taxi parking place; to remove limited stay parking space outside Nos. 13 and 15 Tulse Hill (length 3 metres)
- and extend the adjacent bus stop clearway restrictions to take its place. 3. The proposed Orders are necessary to provide electric vehicle charging places and an electric taxi charging place to meet demand and aid the transition to electric vehicles (Lambeth Council

is currently committed to install over 200 charging points by 2022). Electric vehicles contribute to improvements in air quality, specifically nitrogen dioxide (NO2) levels and reduce greenhouse

- gas emissions and so the Council wishes to encourage their use. The current lack of charging facilities is a barrier for people wishing to buy electric vehicles and so by providing more charging places, the aim is to remove that barrier and give potential users more confidence that they will be able to access charging facilities when necessary.
