ban vehicles from entering that length of Flaxman Road which lies between Coldharbour Lane and a point 15 metres north of Coldharbour Lane (measured on the west side). Alternative routes for vehicles will be available for affected vehicles will be available via Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret

the Order that imposes the one-way working in Flaxman Road between Coldharbour Lane and Pomfret Road would be suspended in so far as that Order bans vehicles proceeding in that length of Flaxman Road from travelling in a direction other than towards Pomfret Road

Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies

4. The ban and suspension will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs. The order will come into force on 25th June 2019 and will

continue for a maximum duration of 1 month or until the works have been completed whichever is the earlier. In practice it is anticipated that the order will only have effect between 11 pm and 6 am on 25th and 26th June 2019, but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on those dates the order will also have effect on subsequent dates and times.
