NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1. No parking/waiting at any time in (i) Amersham Vale, west side, from a point 15m north of Napier Close and for 25m north of that point, (ii) Amersham Grove, both sides, from Amersham Vale for 35m west of Amersham Vale, and (iii) Edward Street, both sides, between a point 25m east of the centreline of Arklow Road and a point 19m west of the centreline of Arklow Road.
- Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
 The Council are satisfied that the works in question will take longer
- than 18 months, therefore the order is intended to come into force on the 12th August 20190 to remain in force until it is revoked.

- 4. The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
