ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A202 GLA ROAD (CAMBERWELL NEW ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING) NOTICE 2019

- I. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable carriageway resurfacing works to take place on the A202 Camberwell New Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle except buses to:
 - (1) stop at the north-eastern kerb-line on the A202 Camberwell New Road, from a point 10 metres north-west of a point opposite the extended south-eastern building line of Nos. 316 to 322 Camberwell New Road, and a point 16.5 metres north-west of the extended north-western building line of No. 319 Camberwell New Road;
 - reduced by 7.6 metres at its north-eastern end to accommodate buses.

 Order will be effective at certain times between 20th July 2019 and 5th August 2019 every day from 12:01 AM to 11:59 PM or when the works

(2) the loading bay outside No. 317 Camberwell New Road will be

- August 2019 every day from 12:01 AM to 11:59 PM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) Any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) Anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
