ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (THURLOW PARK ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY BANNED TURNS) ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to allow telecommunication installation works to take place on Thurlow Park Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) turning right from Birkbeck Hill into Thurlow Park Road;
 - (2) turning right from Thurlow Park Road into Birkbeck Hill;
 - (3) turning right from St Faith's Road into Thurlow Park Road.The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 25th July 2019 and 5:00 PM on 4th August 2019 every night 10:00 PM to 5:00 AM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For St Faith's Road via Thurlow Park Road, Elmcourt Road, Norwood Road, Christchurch Road and Hardel Rise to normal route of travel. For banned right into Birkbeck Hill via Thurlow Park Road, Norwood Road and St Faith's Road to normal route of travel. For banned right out of Birkbeck Hill via Thurlow Park Road, Elmcourt Road, Maley Avenue and Ave Park Road to normal route of travel.
