LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS

- CHEVIOT ROAD NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable the safe access and egress to and from a development site in Cheviot Road.
- the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily ban:-(a) vehicles from waiting (including waiting for the purpose
- of loading or unloading a vehicle) on the north-west side of that length of Cheviot Road which lies on the north-west side of the triangular island site situated at its junction with Knight's Hill, between a point 33.5 metres south-west of the western kerb-line of Knight's Hill and a point 40 metres south-west of that kerb-line
- (b) all vehicles (except buses) from entering that length of Cheviot Road which lies on the north-west side of the triangular island site situated at its junction with Knight's Hill, between Knight's Hill and a point 34 metres south-west of Knight's Hill.

(measured on the north-west side):

- 2. The bans would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic sians.
- 3. Whilst the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply, (a) the one-way system in Cheviot Road between the northeastern kerb-line of the triangular island site situated at its junction with Knight's Hill and a point 34 metres south-west of Knight's Hill would be suspended; and (b) the ban on motor vehicles entering that length of the carriageway of Cheviot Road which lies on the north-west side of the triangular island
- site situated at its junction with Knight's Hill, between a point 34 metres south-west of Knight's Hill and the north-eastern kerb-line of the triangular island site would be suspended.
- 4. The Order would come into force on 17th September 2019 and would continue for a maximum duration of 18 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
