## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

## THE A23 GLA ROAD (BRIXTON ROAD/ BRIXTON HILL, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND BANNED TURN) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to gas main replacement works to take place on Brixton Hill, Brixton Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any:
  - (I) bus or any vehicle exceeding a maximum gross weight of 7.5 tonnes from turning right from Acre Lane into Brixton Hill;
  - (2) vehicle from stopping in the Loading bay on Coldharbour Lane on the side of No.467 Brixton Road.

The Order will be effective between 12:01 AM on 10th August 2019 and 6:00 PM on 30th September 2019 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Efra Road and un-named link road linking Efra Road and Brixton Hill to normal route of travel.
