mph maximum speed limit on motor vehicles proceeding in that length of Mitcham Lane which lies between Campbell Close and the boundary of the London Borough of Merton at

the railway bridge over Mitcham Lane. 3. The majority of the roads in the London Borough of Lambeth, except for those roads subject to Red Route controls, are already subject to a 20 mph maximum speed The proposed Order is necessary to include Mitcham
