THE A200 GLA ROAD (TANNER STREET) (LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2019

- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Orders under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Orders will be to: (I) reduce the length of the loading, unloading and disabled persons' vehicles bay outside Nos 116 to 118 Tanner Street from 33 metres to 13.5 metres, extending the double red line (no stopping at any
 - time) restrictions to accommodate the change; (2) introduce double red line (no stopping at any time) restrictions at the north-western kerb-line of Tanner Street between its junctions with Tooley Street and Druid Street;
 - (3) introduce double red line (no stopping at any time) restrictions at the north-eastern kerb-line of Druid Street between the south-eastern building line of The Downside and Worth Boys Club, Druid Street and a point 46 metres south-eastwards:
 - (4) introduce double red line restrictions (no stopping at any time) restrictions at the south-western kerb-line of Druid Street between its junction with Tanner Street and a point 7 metres northwestwards:
 - (5) permit pedal cycles using the segregated on carriageway cycle track at the south-eastern side of Tanner Street to travel in a northeasterly direction.
- 3. The roads which would be affected by the Orders are the A200 Tanner Street and Druid Street.
