## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A200 GLA ROAD (BERMONDSEY STREET, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable sewer works to take place on Bermondsey Street.
   The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering,
- exiting or proceeding on Bermondsey Street between its junctions with Tooley Street and Magdalen Street.

  The Order will be effective each night between 10:00 PM and 05:00 AM from 28 October 2019 until 31 October 2019 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:

indicated by traffic signs.

- (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via St. Thomas Street, Borough High Street, Long Lane, Tower Bridge Road and Tooley Street and to normal route of travel.
