THE A3 GLA ROAD (KENNINGTON PARK ROAD) (LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2019

- Transport for London, hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Order under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to:
  - (1) prohibit any vehicle except a pedal cycle proceeding in a southeasterly direction on the A3 Kennington Park Road to proceed in any direction other than straight ahead at its junction with Braganza Street;
  - (2) remove a section of the north-eastbound bus lane on the A3 Kennington Park Road between a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Kennings Way and a point 3 metres south-west of its junction with Othello Close;
  - (3) reduce the length of the parking bay outside Penryn House, No 64 Kennington Park Road by 6.5 metres at its south-western end and extend the bay by 0.5 of a metre at its north-eastern end (its total length will be 9.6 metres), extending the double red lines (No Stopping at Any Time) controls outside Penryn House, No. 64 Kennington Park Road to accommodate the change;
  - (4) reduce the length of the electric taxi charging bay outside Penryn House, No 64 Kennington Park Road by 0.5 of a metre at its southwestern end, reduce the underlying double red lines (No Stopping at Any Time) control to accommodate the change.
- 3. The road which would be affected by the Order is A3 Kennington Park Road.
