ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA SIDE ROADS (MINA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable building redevelopment works to take place on the A2 GLA Side Road Mina Road.
 The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering.
- exiting, proceeding or stopping on Mina Road between its junctions with Ivy Church Lane and Old Kent Road.

 The Order will be effective each day from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on 16th September 2019 until 15th March 2021 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Albany Street and Kinglake Street and onto normal route of travel. Cyclists and pedestrians can still use Mina Road.
