ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A3200 GLA ROAD (SOUTHWARK BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable utility works to take place on the A3200 Southwark Bridge Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle proceeding in a southerly direction on Southwark Bridge Road from turning left into Southwark Street.
 - The Order will be effective each night between 09:00 PM and 05:00 AM from 8th November 2019 until 12th November 2019 or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: southbound on Southwark Bridge Road, turn left into Marshalsea Road and Borough High Street and to normal route of travel.
