ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A205 GLA ROAD (WESTHORNE AVENUE, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2019

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable Railway Bridge inspection works to take place at A205 Westhorne Avenue.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering or proceeding on Eltham slip-road connecting Westhorne Avenue and A2 Rochester Way Relief Road.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 16th of September 2019 and 20th of September 2019 everyday 10:00 PM to 5:30 AM or when the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Westhorne Avenue, Rochester Way, The Roundabout at the junctions of Rochester Way and Well Hall Road A205, Westhorne Avenue and Rochester Way Relief Road to normal route of travel.
