

MARRIAGE ACT 1949 & CIVIL PARTNERSHIP ACT 2004

Notice of application for premises to be approved as a venue for civil marriages and civil partnerships

**I, Eliza Infante of Myatt's Field Park Project, The Old Depot,
Cormont Road, London, SE5 9RA** have applied to the London
Borough of Lambeth for approval of premises in pursuance of
the above Acts as a venue where civil marriages may be
solemnised and civil partnerships may be registered. The
premises to which the application relates is:

**The bandstand and roundhouse, Myatt's Field Park,
Cormont Road, London, SE5 9RA**

Regulations made under the above Acts state that premises can
be approved by the Council if in their opinion and amongst other
things:

- i. They are seemly, dignified and regularly available for civil
marriages/partnerships.
- ii. They have adequate fire precautions, and other appropriate
safety precautions.
- iii. They are not used solely or mainly for religious purposes, or
have been so used but have subsequently been used solely or
mainly for other purposes.

Any person wishing to inspect the application and the plans of
the premises may do so at the offices of the **Licensing Section,
London Borough of Lambeth, 6th Floor, International House,
Canterbury Crescent, London, SW9 7QE**, by appointment
only.

Any person may give notice of an objection to the grant of
approval. Objections must be made in writing to the Licensing
Section at the above address and must be
received within the period of **twenty-one days**
beginning on the day on which this notice was
published.
