ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA SIDE ROAD (DEALS GATEWAY, ROYAL BOROUGH OF GREENWICH) TEMPORARY BANNED TURN) ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable DSLAM cabinet installation works to take place on Deals Gateway.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from turning left into Deptford Bridge from Deals Gateway.
The Order will be effective between 28th October 2019 and 30th October 2019 every night from 9:00 PM to 5:30 AM or when those works have been completed whichever is the sooner. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs via Blackheath Road, Blackheath Hill, Shooters Hill Road back to Shooters Hill Road, Blackheath Hill and Blackheath Road to normal route of travel.
