ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE – CARLISLE LANE

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works Virgin Media new connection works to be carried out safely, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth intend to make an Order the effect of which would be to temporarily:-

- (a) ban vehicles from entering that length of Carlisle Lane which lies between the party wall of Arches 197 and 198 Carlisle Lane and the party wall of Arches 200 and 201 Carlisle Lane (approximately 15 metres); and
- (b) suspend the existing one-way traffic system in Carlisle Lane, between Hercules Road and Virgil Street, to allow access and egress for vehicles on either side of the above road closure.

2. An alternative route would be available for affected vehicles via Hercules Road and Virgil Street.

3. The road closure would only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.

4. The Order would come into force on 25th November 2019 and it would continue for a maximum duration of 6 weeks (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that the works would be carried out on 25th, 26th, 27th and 28th November 2019 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed during this time, then the Order may have effect at a subsequent time within the maximum period of 6 weeks.
