

**LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH**  
**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14**  
**TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE LYHAM ROAD**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable water main connection works to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban all vehicles from entering that length of Lyham Road which lies between the northern kerb-line of Prague Place and a point 35 metres north of that kerb-line.
2. An alternative route for affected vehicles will be available via Kings Avenue, Thornbury Road and Lyham Road.
3. Whenever the ban referred to in paragraph 1 above applies the one-way system in Lyham Road between the northern kerb-line of Crescent Lane and the southern kerb-line of Prague Place will be suspended.
4. The road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
5. The Order will come into force on 11th November 2019 and it will continue for a maximum duration of 2 months (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
