

LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14
TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE ST SAVIOUR'S ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable works involving the operation of a crane to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering that length of St Saviour's Road which lies between No. 9 St Saviour's Road and Halliwell Road.
2. The above road closure will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
3. Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via Brixton Hill, Blenheim Gardens and Halliwell Road and vice versa.
4. The Order will come into force on 28th November 2019 and will continue in force for a maximum duration of 1 month (to allow for contingences) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner. In practice it is anticipated that the works will be carried out on 28th November 2019 but if the works cannot be carried out or completed on that day then the Order may have effect on subsequent dates during the maximum period of 1 month.
