## LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 The Lewisham (Sandpit Road and Ashgrove Road, BR1) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council made this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order are indicated below. 1. (1) Road closures and no parking/waiting in (i) Ashgrove Road, BR1

- between Bromley Road and Ladbrook Close, and (ii) Sandpit Road, BR1 between Bromley Road and the north-eastern boundary of No.16 Sandpit Road. (2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closures are via (i) Bromley Hill, Avondale Road, Coniston Road and Ashgrove Road, and vice versa, for of the Ashgrove Road closure, and via (ii) Bromley Hill, Glenbow Road, Farmfield Road and Sandpit Road. and vice versa, for the Sandpit Road closure.
- Exemption is provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- 3. The order comes into force on the 27th January 2020 to remain in force for up to 3 months. 4. The prohibitions apply as, when and to the extent signed on the
- highway.
