ST.ASAPH ROAD – PROVISION OF ROAD HUMPS

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Lewisham Borough Council proposes, under section 90A of the Highways Act 1980, to construct a road hump known as a “raised junction” across the entire carriageway **St. Asaph Road** at its junction with **Avignon Road**, reconstructing the speed tables in Avignon Road north and south of its junction with St. Asaph Road to form one continuous table junction.

The table junction would be of an elevated section of carriageway with a height of 130mm at its highest point with a flat top, extending from approximately 10 metres west of Avignon Road to approximately 20 metres east of Avignon, with on/off ramps each having a length of 1.5 metres.

2. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the road hump can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the office of Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, Fifth Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU.

3. Any objection or other representations relating to the proposed road hump must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made and must be emailed to: traffic@lewisham.gov.uk or posted to Lewisham Transport Policy & Development, Fifth Floor Laurence House, 1 Catford Road, London SE6 4RU, quoting reference ‘Speed Compliance Measures’ to arrive not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this notice. Any objection may be communicated to other persons who may be affected.
