ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A2 GLA SIDE ROAD (MINA ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) PRESCRIBED ROUTE TRAFFIC ORDER 2019

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that on 15th November 2019 it made the above named Order, under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The Order will come into force on 25th November 2019.
2. The general nature and effect of the Order will be to ban all vehicles, except pedal cycles from entering Mina Road at its junction with Ivy Church Lane;
3. The road which would be affected by the Order is the A2 GLA Side Road – Mina Road in the London Borough of Southwark.
4. A copy of the Order, a map indicating the location and effect of the Order and copies of any Order revoked, suspended or varied by the Order can be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of:

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the relevant powers conferred by the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the Order is made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
