ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A203 GLA ROAD (STOCKWELL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow signal water connection works to take place on Stockwell Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) stopping in the Loading and Disabled Persons Vehicle bay outside Nos. 179 to 185 Stockwell Road;
 - (2) stopping in the Parking bay outside Nos. 187 to 193 Stockwell Road. The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the south-eastbound contra-flow bus lane on Stockwell Road between its junctions with Stansfield Road and Brixton Road.
 - The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on the 9th November 2019 and 5:00 PM on the 17th November 2019 every Saturday 7:00 AM to Sunday 5:00 PM or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
