ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A23 GLA SIDE ROAD (SUNNYHILL ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LAMBETH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2019

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow gas connection works to take place on Sunnyhill Road.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting, proceeding or stopping on Sunnyhill Road between its junction with Streatham High Road and the extended eastern building line of No. 6 Sunnyhill Road.

The Order will be effective between 8:00 AM on the 2nd December 2019 and 4:00 PM on the 12th December 2019 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Pinfold Road and Farm Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
