FORMAL PROVISION OF DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACES IN VARIOUS ROADS

[Note: This notice is about the making Orders to formally designate disabled persons' parking places where they are needed. The parking places have already been provided on the ground, but Orders need to be made to formalise the situation and enable enforcement of the parking places where necessary.]

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth on 10th December 2019 made the Lambeth (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) (No. 3) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Brixton "B") (Parking Places) (No. 5) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Clapham "C") (Parking Places) (No. 6) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Clapham "L") (Parking Places) (No. 6) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Kennington) (Parking Places) (No. 6) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Stockwell) (Parking Places) (No. 5) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Streatham Hill West "G") (Parking Places) (No. 4) Order 2019, the Lambeth (Thornton) (Parking Places) (No. 5) Order 2019 and the Lambeth (Waterloo) (Parking Places) (No. 7) Order 2019, under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

2. The general effect of the Orders, which will come into force on 16th December 2019, will be to:

(1) formally provide disabled persons' parking places at the locations specified in the Schedule to this Notice (these parking places will operate at any time and be for the use of vehicles displaying a disabled person's "blue badge" only); and

(2) formally remove other types of parking space as and where it is necessary to accommodate the provision of the above disabled person's parking places.

3. The Orders are necessary to provide new disabled persons' parking places to improve parking facilities for disabled persons, where needed. The parking places have already been provided on the ground on an informal basis and now the Orders are required to reflect the parking situation that currently applies and enable enforcement to be carried out where necessary.

A copy of each of the Orders and documents giving more details about them (including maps) are available for inspection from 9.30 am until 4.30 pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive (except bank/public holidays) until the last day of a period of six weeks beginning with the date on which the Orders are made, at the offices of Lambeth Council's Highways and Enforcement Group (Environment and Growth), 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London SW2 1EG. 6. If any person wishes to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with, that person may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders are made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
