PROPOSED CHANGES TO EXISTING ROAD HUMPS IN KNOLLYS ROAD AND YORK HILL AND CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ROAD HUMP KNOLLYS ROAD

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth ('the Council') propose to make the Lambeth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Amendment No. *) Order 201* under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic
- Regulation Act 1984. The general effect of the Order would be to ban waiting by vehicles at any time (to be indicated by double yellow lines) in the lengths of street specified in the Schedule to this
- Notice (waiting for the purpose of loading or unloading would be permitted, subject to certain time limits and conditions). 3. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the Council propose, under section 90A of the
- Highways Act 1980, to:-(a) remove two sets of speed cushions in Knollys Road, (i) outside Nos. 131/133 and No.
 - 142 Knollys Road and (ii) outside Nos. 160/162 and Nos. 165/167/169/171/173/175 Knollys Road; (b) replace the existing road humps (known as "speed cushions") with new "sinusoidal"
 - road humps in:-Knollys Road, outside Nos. 93 and 114 Knollys Road;
 - (ii) York Hill, (i) at the side of No. 29 Royal Circus; and (ii) at the side of No. 1 Cambrian Close;
 - dify and carry out repairs to the existing road humps in Knollys Road (i) or 121 and Nos. 1 to 5 Jubliee Court, Knollys Road; and (ii) outside Nos.147/149/151 and
 - Nos. 154/156 Knollys Road; provide a new sinusoidal road hump in Knollys Road outside Nos. 174 and 179 Knollys Road.
- [Each "sinusoidal" road hump would be a round-topped, elevated section of carriageway that rises no more than 80 millimetres higher than the existing carriageway, extends across the full
- width of the carriageway from kerb to kerb and is 3 metres long.] 4. The ban on waiting by vehicles is necessary to improve safety, sightlines and visibility for drivers and pedestrians and maintain clear access routes at road junctions. The existing road humps (speed cushions) in the lengths of Knollys Road and York Hill referred to in paragraph
- 1 (a) and (b) above, have limited impact on slowing down traffic. The replacement of the speed cushions with new cycle-friendly sinusoidal road humps, together with the provision of a new sinusoidal road hump is necessary to encourage smoother driving with less pollution-inducing acceleration and deceleration and improve safety by reducing traffic speeds and the potential for road accidents. 5.
