TEMPORARY TRAFFIC AND PARKING RESTRICTIONS
- ROBSON ROAD FOR THAMES WATER TRUNK MAINS
REPLACEMENT WORKS

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that to enable Thames Water
to carry out trunk mains replacement works in and close to

- Norwood Road, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles (except buses) from entering or waiting in that length of Robson Road which lies between Norwood Road and a point 3 metres north-east of the party wall of Nos. 1a and 1d Robson Road (approximately 70 metres).
- The bans will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs.
   Alternative routes will be available for vehicles affected by
- the road closure via Norwood Road, Lancaster Avenue, Thurlow Park Road, Rosendale Road and Robson Road and vice versa.

  4. Whenever the bans referred to in paragraph 1 above apply
- the order that imposes the ban on buses entering that length of Park Hall Road which lies between the north-eastern kerbline of Rosendale Road and the south-western kerblines of Croxted Road and South Croxted Road will be suspended.

  5. The Order will come into force on 6th January 2020 and
- Croxted Road and South Croxted Road will be suspended.

  5. The Order will come into force on 6th January 2020 and will continue for a maximum duration of 10 months or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner.
