ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (NEW KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
2. The purpose of the Order is to enable junction improvement works to take place on the A201 New Kent Road.
3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding into New Kent Road in a westbound direction, between its junctions with Mason Street and Rodney Place;
 - (2) entering, exiting or proceeding into New Kent Road in an eastbound direction between its junctions with Newton Causeway and Balfour Street;
 - (3) entering or exiting into Harper Road at its junction with New Park Road.

The Order will also:

- (4) suspend the westbound bus lane on New Kent Road between its junctions with Rodney Place and Balfour Street;
- (5) suspend the parking bays outside Nos. 163 to 183 New Kent Road;
- (6) restrict the speed limit on New Kent Road to 20 MPH.

The Order will be effective at certain times from 08.00 AM on the 27th January 2020 until 11.59 PM on the 31st July 2020 or when the works have been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via: (for vehicles into Harper Road via New Kent Road, Bricklayers Arms, Great Dover Street, Borough High Street or Falmouth Road and to normal route of travel), (for vehicles to New Kent road via Newington Causeway, Borough High Street, Great Dover Street, Bricklayers Arms and to normal route of travel).
