## ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A100 GLA ROAD (TOWER BRIDGE ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF TOWER HAMLETS AND SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC IN CONNECTION WITH FILMING) ORDER 2020

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 16(A) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984a, as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis and the London Boroughs of Southwark and Tower Hamlet for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to enable filming to take place on the A100 GLA Road Tower Bridge.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to:
  - (1) prohibit any vehicle from entering, exiting or proceeding on the A I 00 Tower Bridge Road, Tower Bridge, Tower Bridge Approach between its junction with Tooley Street and a point I 30 metres south of its junction with East Smithfield (From I:00 AM to 5:00 AM on I 9th January 2020);
    - (2) prohibit pedestrians from proceeding on the western footway of the A100 Tower Bridge between a point 265 metres south of the junction of East Smithfield and Tower Bridge Approach and a point 190 metres north of the junction of Queen Elizabeth Street and Tower Bridge Road. (From 6:00 PM on 18 January 2010 until 6:00 AM on 19th January 2020);
    - (3) revoke the One Way traffic between Tooley Street and Potters Fields during the closures (From 1:00 AM to 5:00 AM on 19th January 2020);
    - (4) allow temporary holds to occur for short durations at these locations. (From 18:00 on Saturday 18 January until 1:00 AM 19th January 2020 and then again from 5:00 AM to 6:00 AM on 19th January 2020).

The Order will be effective from 1:00 AM on 19th January 2020 to 6:00 AM on 19th January 2020 or until the filming has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
  - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
  - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
