NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Lewisham Council intend to make this temporary traffic order under the provisions of section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 because of Thames Water works on and adjacent to the highway. The effects of the order will be as indicated below.

- 1. (1) Road closure and no parking/waiting in (i) Bartram Road, SE4 between Buckthorne Road and Nos.17/19, and (ii) Grangemill Way, SE6 between Nos.7/9 & 15. (2) The alternative routes for vehicular traffic affected by the closure of Bartram Road shall be via Brockley Road, Courtrai Road and Buckthorne Road, and vice versa, and those for the closure of Grangemill Way shall be via Firhill Road, Athelney Street and Grangemill Road, and vice versa.
- Exemption will be provided in the order for vehicles engaged on the works, vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency and anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform.
- The order is intended to come into force on the 10th February 2020 to remain in force for up to 4 months.
 The prohibitions will apply as when and to the extent signed on
- **4.** The prohibitions will apply as, when and to the extent signed on the highway.
