- iunction improvement works (including footway and carriageway resurfacing) to be carried out, the Council of the London Borough of Lambeth has made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily ban vehicles from entering:-

2. NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that to enable road

- (a) that length of Greenhurst Road which lies between Truslove Road and Lakeview Road: and
- (b) that length of Lamberhurst Road that lies between Greenhurst Road and the eastern boundary of No. 92 Lamberhurst Road

Alternative routes for affected vehicles will be available via (a) Greenhurst Road, Cheviot Road and Lamberhurst Road and

vice versa; and (b) Truslove Road, Greenhurst Road. Cheviot Road and Lamberhurst Road and vice versa. The road closures described above will only apply at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by the placing of the appropriate traffic signs, and vehicles will be able to

gain access to and egress from properties, as far as the extent of the works permits that. 4. The Order referred to in paragraph 1 above will come into force on 24th February 2020 and the Order referred to in

paragraph 2 above will come into force on 16th March 2020. Both Orders will continue for a maximum duration of 6 weeks (to allow for contingencies) or until the works have been completed whichever is the sooner, although it is anticipated that the Order referred to in paragraph 1 above will only have effect for about 2-3 days and the Order referred to in paragraph 2 above will only have effect for about 5-6 days.
