ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A205 GLA ROAD (STANSTEAD ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF LEWISHAM) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London in consultation with the London Borough of Lewisham hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow ducting works to take place on Stanstead Road.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (1) entering, exiting or proceeding on Stanstead Road between its junctions with Rockbourne Road and Sunderland Road;
 - (2) stopping on Stanstead Road between its junctions with Sunderland Road and Wastdale Road;
 - (3) stopping on Sunderland Road between its junctions with Stanstead Road and Waldram Park Road.

The Order will be effective between 9:00 PM on the 16th March 2020 and 5:00 AM on the 26th March 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via Sunderland Road, Waldram Park Road, Montrose Way and Rockbourne Road or reverse to normal route of travel.
