ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A201 GLA ROAD (LONDON ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2020

- 1. Transport for London hereby gives notice that it intends to make the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to allow sewer cleansing works to take place on the A201 London Road. 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit all north-westbound buses
- from entering or proceeding on London Road, between Elephant and Castle Roundahout and Lambeth Road. The Order will be effective between 10:00 PM on 15th March 2020 and 5:00 AM on 20th March 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibition will apply only during such times and to such extent as
- 4. The prohibition will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;

shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- 5. At such times as the prohibition is in force an alternative route will be indicated by traffic signs via St. Georges Road, Lambeth Road, London Road and to normal route of travel.
