ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 THE A2 GLA ROAD (OLD KENT ROAD, LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC AND STOPPING) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- 2. The purpose of the Order is to enable junction improvement works to take place at A2 Old Kent Road and Trafalgar Avenue.
- 3. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from:
 - (I) turning left from Old Kent Road north-westbound into Trafalgar Avenue;
 - (2) stopping in the Loading bay outside No. 1a Trafalgar Avenue. The Order will be effective at certain times from 7.00 AM on the 12th February 2020 until 8.00 PM on the 3rd March 2020 or when the works have been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (1) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
- At such times as the prohibitions are in force alternative routes will be indicated by traffic signs. For Trafalgar Avenue via Old Kent Road (westbound), Bricklayers Arms and Old Kent Road (eastbound) to normal route of travel.
