ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE A217 GLA ROAD (WANDSWORTH PLAIN, LONDON BOROUGH OF WANDSWORTH) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF STOPPING AND SUSPENSION OF BUS LANE) ORDER 2020

- Transport for London hereby gives notice that it has made the above named Traffic Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 for the purpose specified in paragraph 2. The effect of the Order is summarised in paragraph 3.
- The purpose of the Order is to allow ducting works to take place on Wandsworth Plain.
- The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle from stopping on Wandsworth Plain between its junctions with All Saints Passage and Armoury Way.

The Order will also permit all vehicles to use the northbound bus lane on Wandsworth Plain between its junction with All Saints Passage and Armoury Way.

The Order will be effective between 7:00 AM on the 22nd February and 7:00 PM on the 24th February 2020 or until the works has been completed. The prohibitions will apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

- 4. The prohibitions will not apply in respect of:
 - (I) any vehicle being used for the purposes of those works or for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (2) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a person authorised by Transport for London.
