

LICENSING ACT 2003

Application for Grant of Premises Licence

Live Nation (Music) UK Limited has applied to the London Borough of Lambeth for the grant of a Premises Licence, in respect of the following premises:

Clapham Common Event Site, SW4 0JA

which would authorise the following licensable activities:

Provision of regulated entertainment including (a) plays, (b) films, (c) indoor sporting events, (e) live music, (f) recorded music, (g) performances of dance, (h) anything of a similar description to that falling within (e), (f) or (g), provision of entertainment facilities including (i) making music, (j) dancing, (k) entertainment of a similar description to that falling within (i) or (j), provision of (l) late night refreshment and (m) Supply of alcohol (on and off sales) between the hours of 13:00 – 23:00 on Friday dates, 11:00 – 23:00 Saturday dates, 11:00 – 22:30 Sunday dates, 11:00 – 23:00 Sunday dates (followed by Bank Holiday), 12:00 – 21:00 Monday dates and 12:00 – 22:30 Bank Holiday Monday dates.

The record of this application may be inspected during normal office hours by an appointment at the Licensing Section, London Borough of Lambeth, 3rd Floor, Civic Centre, 6 Brixton Hill, London, SW2 1EG, or via the licensing authority's website, at www.lambeth.gov.uk/licensing

A responsible authority or any other person may make representation to the licensing authority in respect of this application. Representations must be made in writing, either by post to the above address, or by email to licensing@lambeth.gov.uk and must be received no later than 2nd April 2020.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with a licensing application, and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for that offence shall not exceed level 5 on the standard scale (£5,000).
